 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALTHA ANDERSON
 IRONSIDE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of LOCEY WELL a tributary of WILLOW CREEK tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 123.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-629. The date of priority is MARCH 30, 1954. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 1.54 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation and agreement recorded on Pages 830-832, Volume 3, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:


