## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

### THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

#### PIONEER HI-BRED INTERNATIONAL INC. 2212 SE 9TH STREET HERMISTON OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL (UMAT 56771), in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 20.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7183. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or, with approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 5, 2012, at Special Order Volume 85, Page 867, approving Transfer Application T-11256, and together with Certificates 87368, 87373, 87374, 89052 and transfer T-11254, supersedes Certificate 79889, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
