confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL within the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4918. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), if available at the original wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

Water may be appropriated at any time during the year, provided the rate does not exceed 0.67 CFS and the volume does not exceed 305.6 ACRE FEET in any year.
