**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The area submerged by the reservoirs is as follows:

#### CONDITIONS OF USE

Measurement, recording and reporting:

- A. The water user shall maintain all required measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water stored, and may require the water user to report water storage on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, the periods of water use, and the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the maintenance of an outlet pipe. This requirement may be waived if the Department determines other means have been provided to evacuate water when necessary.

The water user shall pass all live flow outside the storage season described above.

The Director may require the water user to measure inflow and outflow, above and below the reservoir respectively, to ensure that live flow is not impeded outside the storage season. Measurement devices and their implementation must be acceptable to the Director, and the Director may require that data be recorded on a specified periodic basis and reported to the Department annually or more frequently.

This right allows an annual appropriation (not to exceed the specified volume). This right does not provide for the appropriation of water for out-of-reservoir uses, the maintenance of the water level or maintaining a suitable freshwater condition. If any water is to be used for out-of-reservoir purposes, a secondary water right is required. If any additional live flow is to be appropriated to maintain either the water level or a suitable freshwater condition, an additional water right is required.

Notwithstanding that Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination that fish passage and/or a fishway is not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish passage and/or a fishway to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.

The water user shall not release stored water from the reservoir(s) June 1 through October 31 unless determined necessary by the Water Resources Department to satisfy downstream rights.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
