 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KIRPAL LIGHT SATSANG INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to ROCK CREEK (BOTTLE CREEK), a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for MAINTENANCE OF A FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM AND IRRIGATION of 34.5 ACRES and.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50121. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.113 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being .10 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 34.5 acres and .013 for MAINTENANCE OF THE FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 9, 2012, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 34, approving Transfer Application T-9448, and together with Certificate 87663, supersedes Certificate 87404, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
