## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BOB AND VINA MORRISON HC 70 BOX 1580 ANTLERS OK 74523

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary to POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 38.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion (NEWT YOUNG DITCH), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.

Within one year after receiving written notification from the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is required, the water user shall install a screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW criteria. Once installed, the water user shall continue to maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
