CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 125.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9262. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 6, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FROM STUTZMAN WELL AND 1.56 CFS FROM HOGAN WELL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation, or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

[NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation, nor exceed the capacity of the original point of appropriation at time of perfection of this right, described as follows:


When required by the Department, the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 432, approving Transfer Application 7374, supercedes Certificate 53451, State record of Water Right Certificates.
