CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LAKEVIEW WATER USERS INC
91164 WATER USERS LANE
LAKEVIEW OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of COTTONWOOD CREEK, COTTONWOOD CREEK RESERVOIR, DREWS CREEK, AND DREWS CREEK RESERVOIR, tributaries of GOOSE LAKE, for IRRIGATION of 14.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court in the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, Page 478. The dates of priority are January 21, 1907 for Drews Creek, and July 31, 1908 for Cottonwood Creek.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.28 CFS FROM DREWS CREEK AND RESERVOIR AND 0.25 CFS FROM COTTONWOOD CREEK AND RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 28, 2009 at Special Order Volume 78, Page 668, approving Transfer Application 10086, and together with Certificate 85703 supercedes Certificate 82202, State record of Water Right Certificates.
