confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK of the ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of the ILLINOIS RIVER, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under permit S-36172. The date of priority is MARCH 8, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.00 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND measured at the point of diversion.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.
