CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KATHERINE GEISLER
MOUNT VERNON, OR 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-18828. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

13 S	29 E	WM	27	NW NE	50 FEET SOUTH AND 3380 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 86539, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 3, 2014, and recorded at Volume 91, Page 898, approving Transfer Application T-11454.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the location description of the point of diversion. Certificate 89114 erroneously describes the point of diversion as being within Section 22, T 13 S, R 29 E, WM. The actual location is within Section 27, T 13 S, R 29 E, WM. This certificate is issued to supersede certificate 89114.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
