CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T. M. STOVER, G. H. GUERIN, JR., J. T. GUERIN, E. M. HOFFMAN AND E. F. HOFFMAN MYRTLE POINT, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SPRINGS DESIGNATED AS SPRING NO. 1 AND SPRING NO. 2, located in the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Sec. 23, T. 29 S, R. 12 W., W.M. for DOMESTIC USES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2346. The date of priority is JANUARY 15, 1915. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.182 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

On so much of the following described tracts of land as lie north of the Middle Fork of the Coquille River:

In Township Twenty-nine South, Range Twelve West of the Willamette Meridian in Coos County, Oregon:--

In Section Twenty-three thereof, the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter;

In Section Twenty-Two thereof: The Northeast quarter, the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter making 440 acres belonging to G. H. Guerin, Jr. and J. T. Guerin;

In said Section Twenty-two: The Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section, also the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section except a tract of 6.6 acres hereinafter described as belonging to E. F. Hoffman; also in Section 22; Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; also in said Section 23 thereof: All of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter

excepting all of said forty acre tract which lies south of the Pickthorn and Breuer Change of the Myrtle Point-Roseburg County Road or East of Mill Creek, belonging to said T. M. Stover;

In said Section 22 and in the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section the following tract of land containing 6.6 acres of land described as follows: Beginning at the quarter section corner between Sections 22 and 27 of said Township and Range run thence North 1060 feet to a stake, thence east 126 feet to a stake; thence South 29° 45' East 710 feet to the center of the old County Road; thence South 52° 45' West 260 feet; thence South 35° 40' West 360 feet, thence West 50 feet to place of beginning, said tract of 6.6 acres belonging to E. F. Hoffman;

In said Section 22: the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the East half of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter;

In Section 27 of said Township and Range: the North half of the Northwest quarter of said Section, said lands belonging to E. M. Hoffman.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 6424, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August _______, 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11662.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
