This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1874.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 1.314 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
