confirms the right to the use of the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER for the purpose of the IRRIGATION of 56.0 ACRES of land, and STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1875.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted from POD L.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at POD's C & D. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Notwithstanding that Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination by-pass devices are not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate by-pass devices to prevent fish from entering the diversion, and to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE, ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION, and PARTIAL CANCELLATION OF WATER RIGHT approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 21, 2003 at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1100, approving Transfer Application T-8732, and corrected by Special Order Volume 57 page 137 on August 12, 2003, and supersedes Certificate 555, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
