CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUD-RICH POTATO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3895. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.314 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) being: 0.171 cfs from Well #2, and 0.143 cfs from Well #3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

4 N	28 E	WM	28	SW NE	WELL #2 - 460 FEET NORTH AND 986 FEET EAST FROM CENTER OF SECTION 28
4 N	28 E	WM	28	SW NE	WELL #3 - 681 FEET NORTH AND 785 FEET EAST FROM CENTER OF SECTION 28

The period of allowed use is year round.

The total diversion shall not exceed 109.5 acre-feet per year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

4 N	28 E	WM	30	SE SE	WELL #1 - 200 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 30

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE, PLACE OF USE, AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 8, 1992, at Special Order Volume 46, Page 411, approving Transfer Application T-6417, and together with Certificate 76742, supercedes Certificate 44897, State record of Water Right Certificates.
