CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 54.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 29.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8085. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.06 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters, or other approved suitable measuring devices, in good working order at each point of appropriation.

B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 7, 2011, at Special Order Volume 84, Page 508, approving Transfer Application 11152, supercedes Certificate 55411, State record of Water Right Certificates.
