## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE D DAWSON PO BOX 618 RIDDLE OR 97469

confirms the right to use the waters of MITCHELL CREEK (aka ASH CREEK), a tributary of COW CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 17281. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 18, 1946. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.07 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
30 S	5 W	WM	31	SE NW	1260 FEET NORTH AND 410 FEET WEST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The use of water under this and the remainder of the water right described in Certificate 19854 shall be subject to the conditions of a stipulated agreement referenced in the order of the Hearings Referee entered April 8, 1993 in the Special Order Records at Volume 47, Page 194, and by reference made a part herein.

The following conditions shall be included on all subsequent water right certificates describing these water rights:

- a. Any water appropriated shall require a system using a headgate (or pump) and a measuring device at each point of diversion.
- b. Any water appropriated shall be run through pipes or other enclosed devices and not open ditches to the point of use, beginning with the 1994 irrigation season.
- c. No water shall be appropriated by use of a dam across Mitchell Creek aka Ash Creek. The user of water may use a device which partially diverts Ash Creek, but shall not construct, nor make use of, nor allow a dam across the full width of Ash Creek.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 19, 1993, at Special Order Volume 47 Page 225, approving Transfer Application T-6739, amended by an order entered August, 26, 1993, at Special Order Volume 47 page 307, and together with Certificate 68259, supercedes Certificate 19854, State record of Water Right Certificates.
