# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

### THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, tributary of the EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 84.4 ACRES AND STOCK FOR TRACT #2 AND IRRIGATION OF 28.55 ACRES FOR TRACT #4.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in VOLUMES 1 AND 5, AT PAGES 252 AND 397. The date of Priority is 1865 FOR TRACT #2 AND 1908 FOR TRACT #4.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.69 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) FOR TRACT #2, AND 0.36 CFS FOR TRACT #4, if available at the authorized points of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The period of use is April 1 through October 31 of each year.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675; you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 18, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 460, approving Transfer Application 8620, and together with T-8471, T-8918, T-9047, and T-9048, supercedes Certificate 7139, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
