CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

AUGUST AND ANNAMARIA PICOLLO
637 BUTTE FALLS HWY
PROSPECT OR 97536

confirms the right to use the waters of RED BLANKET CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2786. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
32 S	3 E	WM	34	SW NW	NEW - 100 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

32 S	3 E	WM	26	NW NW	MONEY DITCH NO. 1

The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 13, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 2200, approving Transfer Application 8106, supercedes Certificate 56480, State record of Water Right Certificates.
