 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE FORK MALHEUR RIVER, a tributary of the MALHEUR RIVER for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MALHUER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 228. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-TWENTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1½ acre-feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre-foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st, or 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
