CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the BUCK CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 127.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7361. The date of priority is APRIL 29, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.59 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.08 CFS FROM WELL 1 FOR IRRIGATION OF 6.61 ACRES AND 1.51 CFS FROM NEW WELL FOR IRRIGATION OF 120.49 ACRES or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The following provision shall be effective when in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

The pump system shall include an access port for measuring water level;

The pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE AND ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 14, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 851, together with Certificate 76226, supercedes Certificate 75331, State record of Water Right Certificates.
