## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SILVER LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT PO BOX 69 SILVER LAKE OR 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the FORT ROCK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6670. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original points of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This portion of this right for supplemental irrigation is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The quantity of water diverted at the authorized points of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

The wells at the authorized points of appropriation shall be maintained to the well construction standards in effect as of May 10, 1991, and must include an access port.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 28, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 1519, approving Transfer Application 6871, together with Certificate 76363, supercedes Certificate 76234, State record of Water Right Certificates.
