 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN A JOHNSON & SON
 RT 2 YAMHILL, OR 97148

confirms the right to use the waters of a reservoir (constructed under Application R-27783, Permit R1517) and an unnamed stream (also referred to as North stream and North reservoir), tributary of North Yamhill River for IRRIGATION of 28.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22425. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
