 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHESTER A. SMITH

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 5364. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1922. The right limited to not more than 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate correctly describes the name of the river that Cow Creek is tributary to and describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 58504, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 14, 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11627.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
