## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TUALATIN RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER, for STOCK WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50669. The date of priority is JANUARY 11, 1989 FOR 12,000 GALLONS PER DAY (GPD) AND JULY 7, 1989 FOR 240 GPD. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 12,240 GPD or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
