 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MIKE & ANNE WAGNER  
 25383 N MIDDLETON RD  
 MIDDLETON ID 83644

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, a tributary of Malheur River, for IRRIGATION of 29.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit No. U-414. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 5, 1951. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order

The right to the use of the water for the purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 2, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 362, approving Transfer Application T-11588, and together with Certificate 89199, supersedes Certificate 47837, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
