 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JEDEDIAH AYLETT  
 ROUTE 1, BOX 1818  
 HERMISTON, OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1 AND 2 in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 12.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-4929. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 16, 1971, FOR 0.132 CFS AND DECEMBER 3, 1971, FOR 0.024 CFS. The right is limited to not more than 0.156 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

4 N	27 E	WM	28	SE NW	WELL 1: 3700 FEET NORTH AND 1390 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28
4 N	27 E	WM	28	NW SW	WELL 2: 1650 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE WELLS SHALL NOT EXCEED 120 FEET IN DEPTH, NOR APPROPRIATE WATER FROM AN AQUIFER BELOW THAT DEPTH.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 60552, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 29 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11514.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
