CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of GREASY CREEK and MILTS POND constructed under Application No. R-50764, Permit No. R-5972, a tributary of MARY'S RIVER for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-36801. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1973. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, from reservoir for fish culture, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 42989, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Oct. 23 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11495.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
