CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RANDY MARSHALL  
56117 MULLER RD  
WAMIC, OR 97063

confirms the right to use the waters of SEEPAGE AND WASTE WATER OF THE GATE AND ROCK CREEK AND THREE MILE CREEK DITCH COS., for IRRIGATION of 20.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8297. The date of priority is JANUARY 24, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE ¼ NE ¼, SECTION 22, T 4 S, R 12 E, W.M. or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
4 S	12 E	WM	23	NW NE	340 FEET SOUTH & 869 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 23

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
4 S	12 E	WM	23	NW NE	10.0
4 S	12 E	WM	23	NE NW	10.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
4 S	12 E	WM	22	SE NE

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 6, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 828, approving Transfer Application 7582, and supercedes Certificate 8993, State record of Water Right Certificates.
