CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

WILLOW VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK LOST RIVER, WOOLLEN CREEK, BUMPHEAD, WILLOW VALLEY, AND THREE MILE FLAT RESERVOIRS, tributary to LOST RIVER AND TULE LAKE for PRIMARY IRRIGATION of 753.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22962.

The date of priority is MARCH 29, 1954.

This right is limited to 9.85 Cubic Feet per Second (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The storage reservoirs were constructed under Permit Numbers R-628, R-979, R-980, R-981.

The points of diversion are located:

North Fork Lost River: 149 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER SECTION 13, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 41 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

Woollen Creek: SOUTH 49 DEGREES 20 MINUTES EAST 1227 FEET FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER SECTION 33, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 40 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

Bumphead Reservoir: 1700 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 31, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Willow Valley Reservoir: 50 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 19, being within LOT 1 (NW ¼ NW ¼) of Section 19, Township 41 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

Three Mile Flat Reservoir: 1410 FEET NORTH AND 2600 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 3, being within the NE ¼ SW ¼ SECTION 3, Township 41 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

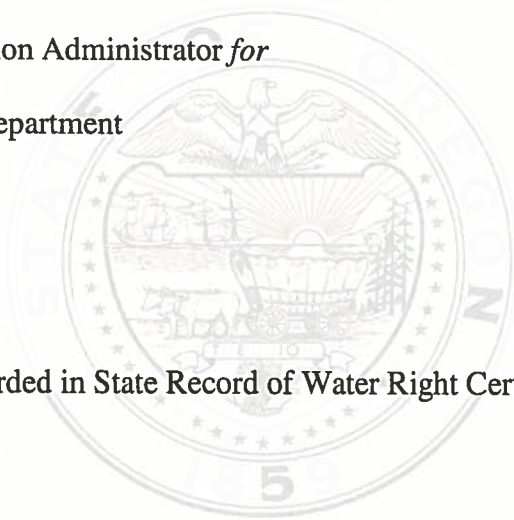
