CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLOW VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT

confirms the right to use the waters of BUMPHEAD, WILLOW VALLEY, AND THREE MILE FLAT RESERVOIRS, tributary to LOST RIVER AND TULE LAKE for IRRIGATION of 887.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24041.

The date of priority is JANUARY 26, 1956.

This right is limited to 12.81 Cubic Feet per Second (CFS), being 1.11 CFS from Bumphead Reservoir, 10.61 CFS from Willow Valley Reservoir and 1.09 CFS from Three Mile Flat Reservoir, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The storage reservoirs were constructed under Permit Numbers R-979, R-980 and R-981.

The points of diversion are located:

Bumphead Reservoir: 1700 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 31, being within the NE ¼ SW ¼ of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

Willow Valley Reservoir: 50 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 19, being within the NW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 19, Township 41 South, Range 14.5 East, W.M.

Three Mile Flat Reservoir: 1410 FEET NORTH AND 2600 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 3, being within the NE ¼ SW ¼ SECTION 3, Township 41 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
