CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILL CREEK LAND LLC 7900 NE MILL CREEK RD PRINEVILLE OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of OCHOCO CREEK, for DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE, AND IRRIGATION OF 14.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1868.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for Domestic and Stock use, and 0.19 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year, if available at the original point of diversion: NO NAME DITCH, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain fish screens or fish by-pass devices on the diversion point. Fish screens of by-pass devices must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and installed under the general supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations of the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 25, 2013, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 1220, approving Transfer Application T-11465, and together with Certificate 87898, supersedes Certificate 83675, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
