A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain fish screens or fish by-pass devices on the diversion point. Fish screens of by-pass devices must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and installed under the general supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 25, 2013, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 1220, approving Transfer Application T-11465, and together with Certificate 87899, supersedes Certificate 83658, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
