CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EVERETT O. & LENA E. WATTERS
 RT 1 BOX 218
 LEBANON, OR 97355

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK FALL CREEK, SPRING BRANCH AND RESERVOIRS (constructed under Application R-26701, Permit R-1291), a tributary to MCDOWELL CREEK for IRRIGATION of 15.6 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20901. The date of priority is DECEMBER 10, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) being 0.09 cfs from the creek and reservoir and 0.09 cfs from Spring Branch and reservoir, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit R-1291. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
