CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

P.W. HOTCHKISS
LAKEVIEW, OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of North Fork & South Fork Camp Creek and Bauers Creek, both tributary to THOMAS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 284.9 ACRES and STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 233. The date of priority is APRIL 21, 1871.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-fourths acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half acre foot per acre during any 30-day period after June 1st of each year; and two and one-half acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed one-fortieth of a second foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
