CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, Well 1 (MARI 3471) and Well 2 (MARI 56548), tributary to ABIQUA CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 61.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2068. The date of priority is MARCH 1, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.78 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The water user shall maintain the in-line flow meters or other suitable measuring devices in good working order.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 23, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 758, approving Transfer Application T-10093, and supersedes Certificate 81981, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
