CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO  
STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the COLUMBIA RIVER, tributary to the PACIFIC OCEAN, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-34254. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1969, plus one minute. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.459 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and is further limited to 223.27 ACRE FEET per year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from March 1 through October 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion previously authorized under Certificate 37975:

to the mouth of the Columbia River at River Mile 0.0.

The instream right established by this Allocation of Conserved Water process shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 37975, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Page 281, approving Conserved Water Application CW-63. This Certificate together with Certificate 86758, and the conserved water under CW-63, supersedes Certificate 37975, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
