confirms the right to use the waters of MARYS RIVER, tributary to WILLAMETTE RIVER for MUNICIPAL USE of ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13556. The date of priority is MARCH 11, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

Water shall only be used during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is located within the City of Philomath.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled.

Water may be applied to lands not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
