 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT AND JOANN LYON

confirms the right to use the waters of FOURBIT CREEK, a tributary of BIG BUTTE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 78.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3579. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 2, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.98 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new points of diversion. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction, and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 18, 2014, approving Transfer Application T- 11842, and supersedes Certificate 4898, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
