CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C. L. REAM
POST, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of DRAKE CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic use.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 649, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 31, 2014, approving Transfer Application T-11750.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
