 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ADA WESTON

 GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of DRAIN CREEK, a tributary of VANNOY CREEK, tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-16358. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cfs per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued pursuant to remanded Transfer Application T-8366 involving *Fort Vannoy Irrigation District v. Water Resources Commission*. This certificate describes the portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15340, NOT modified by the provisions of a superseding order entered JAN 27 2015 in Special Order Volume 93, Pages 1150-1155 approving Transfer Application T-8366. This certificate supersedes Certificate 81594.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
