 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FORT VANNOY IRRIGATION DISTRICT
 665 HUNT LANE
 GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of DUTCHER CREEK, a tributary of VANNOY CREEK, tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 25.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-9693. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1922. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

This certificate is issued pursuant to remanded Transfer Application T-8366 involving *Fort Vannoy Irrigation District v. Water Resources Commission*. This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 8943, NOT modified by the provisions of a superseding order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 27, 2015, recorded in Special Order Volume 93, Pages 1156-1162 approving Transfer Application T-7086.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
