CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G W. MCFARLANE
SISTERS, OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of WHYCHUS CREEK (formerly known as SQUAW CREEK), a tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION of 30.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1 at Page 120. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.484 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 83355, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 24 2015, approving Allocation of Conserved Water CW-71. This certificate together with Certificate ~~89831~~, supersedes Certificate 83355.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
