CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TRECO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for YEAR-ROUND PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 12.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8856. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the period of April 1 to September 30. The right is further limited to the diversion of 1 acre foot for each acre irrigated during the period of October 1 to March 31. The supplemental portion of this right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68197, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 18 2015, approving Transfer Application T-11837.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
