This right was perfected under Permit G-10853. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 24, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 196.67 GALLONS PER MINUTE OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN CASE OF A HIGHER PUMPING RATE FOR ONLY PART OF EACH DAY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

This right is limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others. If use of water under this right is found to interfere with appropriation of ground water under prior existing water rights, use of the Klupenger Well 3 shall be regulated so as to eliminate the interference.

If used for field irrigation for nursery stock, such use is not restricted to the defined agricultural irrigation season.

The right is for the beneficial use of water.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
