This right is limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others. Daily's irrigation well (35/1w-33 aad), use of the Murray Well under this right shall be regulated so as to eliminate the interference.

If used for field irrigation for nursery stock, such use is not restricted to the defined agricultural irrigation season.
