confirms the right to use the waters of ROGERS NO. 1 WELL in the GRANITE CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 63.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-324. The date of priority is APRIL 20, 1956. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.80 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
