 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

YAMSAY LAND AND CATTLE COMPANY
 OF WILLIAMS BUILDING
 KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of YAMSAY WELL No. 2 in the COW CREEK (Williamson River) for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION 88.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2243. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 4, 1962. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.11 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the:

31 S	7 E	WM	1	NE SE	70 FEET NORTH AND 760 FEET WEST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6, T31S, R8E

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


