CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the to UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION of 5.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5451. The date of priority is AUGUST 23, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
4 N	29 E	WM	10	SE NW	3651 FEET NORTH AND 1492 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

4 N	29 E	WM	10	SE NW	1100 FEET NORTH AND 720 FEET WEST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation being alluvial sands and gravels overlying basalt.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 10, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 696, approving Transfer Application 8232, and together with Certificate 76162, supersedes Certificate 54082, State record of Water Right Certificates.
