CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a BRANCH OF DIXIE CREEK, a tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for MUNICIPAL USES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20811. The date of priority is OCTOBER 12, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is an infiltration gallery located as follows:

The amount of water used for municipal use is limited to 1.0 cubic foot per second or its equivalent, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 154.8 acre-feet during the irrigation season of April 1 through September 30 of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of lawfully water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source at the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE, PLACE OF USE, AND POINT OF DIVERSION TO GROUND WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 8, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 1399, approving Transfer Application 8273, supercedes Certificate 21795, State record of Water Right Certificates.
