CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 5, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3125. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.74 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well.

The well is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 8, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 657, approving Transfer Application 7867, and supercedes Certificate 41998, State record of Water Right Certificates.
